Travel Baseball and Recreation Baseball will not conflict. Throughout the rec. season, 7U and 8U Travel will only practice on Saturday afternoons (after the rec. games are complete) and Sunday afternoons. Once the rec. season is over, travel teams may practice during the week, depending on the tournament schedule. Practices typically last approximately 2 hours. Beginning Sunday, May 9th, both age groups may begin playing "Sunday Showcase" games. These are double-header games against local teams. Game times for Sunday Showcase games are typically 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. See below for the 2010 schedule to date. (Schedule subject to change).

It is our desire to have two travel teams per age group. The teams are split into an "A" (Blue) and "B" (Red) team. Both teams will play Sunday Showcase games and participate in local tournaments.

Travel Team Fees:

The cost to participate is approximately \$200-\$250 plus a partial uniform cost. If your team participates in the Greensburg tournament and your family decides to stay over night, that cost is additional. Cost to travel to and from tournaments is additional as well.

Q&A

1. Is it required for my child to attend the travel team evaluations to play travel baseball?
Answer: Yes, it is required for your child to be evaluated to participate. Please make sure s/he is in attendance if s/he has an interest in participating in travel baseball.
2. How many kids will be selected to participate in travel baseball?
Answer: It is our desire that we have enough athletes participating in evaluations to fill two teams per age group.
3. If my child participates, will s/he have the opportunity to play?
Answer: Yes, it is required that each athlete sit no more than 2 innings per game. All athletes bat in the order. Unlike rec. baseball, only 10 play on the field -v- 12 players on the field in recreation baseball.
4. Our family has vacation planned this summer. Do I have to attend every tournament?
Answer: No, we realize families have most likely planned for vacation(s) this summer. Although, we anticipate your family may miss some practices and/or games, we hope your child will not miss more than one tournament.
5. Is it possible to participate at a lower cost?
Answer: Yes, we ask each athlete to obtain a team sponsor. If successful, a portion of your fee is waived.
